

We are continuing in our two week series on the “seven words from the cross.” The Gospels record seven phrases that Jesus spoke during the crucifixion. Each one is deep with meaning. Each one reveals something of the heart of God, the work of Christ and the wonder of our redemption.

We will meditate on one of these “words” from the cross and then we will take communion as a church. Our prayer is that God will use this time to guide our way to Good Friday and then Easter and the explosion of life, joy and power that comes with it.

HERE ARE THE SEVEN WORDS:

- 1) “Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.” (Luke 23:34)
- 2) “Truly I say to you, today you will be with me in paradise.” (Luke 23:43)
- 3) “Woman, behold your son... (John) Behold your mother.” (John 19:26-27)
- 4) “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?” (Mark 15:34)
- 5) “I thirst.” (John 19:30)
- 6) “It is finished.” (John 19:30)
- 7) “Father, into yours hands I commend my spirit.” (Luke 23:46)
